## Rules for the Hotel:

- Notify a director/chaperone upon check-in if there are any problems with your room.
- No boys allowed in girls rooms and no girls allowed in boys rooms. **NO EXCEPTIONS!!!**
- There will be a time for "lights out" listed on the itinerary. No one is allowed outside his or her room past that time.
- Do not call other rooms after lights out
- **DO NOT ORDER ROOM SERVICE OR ANYTHING ELSE TO YOUR ROOM.**
- **DO NOT MAKE LOCAL OR LONG DISTANCE PHONE CALLS FROM YOUR ROOM. IF YOU NEED TO CALL SOMEONE, USE A CELL PHONE.**

## Medication Policy

- **All medications from Vitamins to Prescription medications must follow this policy!**
- Any medications must be in their original container. You may want to include only enough doses for the duration of the trip (plus a couple of extra in case of travel delays).
- A notarized document should be prepared for your child, specifying any medications that he/she regularly takes, and that they can take as needed (e.g. headaches, sinus problems). This should include prescribed medications, over-the-counter medications, vitamins, herbal preparations. Please specify if your child self-administers medications, carries an inhaler, epi-pen, etc
- Mr. Nelson and Mr. Sunderland will be contacting the clinic to verify all students' current medication needs that are on file. They will ensure that necessary medications are picked up from the clinic.
- A parent must review the medications and instructions with Dianne Nelson on or before February 24<sup>th</sup>. The medications will then be given to your child's assigned chaperone unless the student has permission to self-medicate.
